

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for Contract 2009-SST1: Side Stream Treatment System Procurement will be received by The Harrisburg Authority, 212 Locust Street, Suite 302, Harrisburg, PA 17101 until 11:00 A.M. Prevailing Time on Monday November 16, 2009 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The contract includes the procurement of a full-scale Side Stream Treatment System that will be installed as a part of the Authority's Side Stream Treatment and HPOAS Improvements Project. The Owner shall select one (1) qualified, responsive, responsible Bidder for procurement of the Side Stream Treatment equipment who will be required to conduct an on-site, "Pilot to prove" pilot test to validate the Bidders information.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 21, 2009, in the conference room at the Harrisburg Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility located at 1662 South Cameron Street Harrisburg, PA 17104. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is mandatory.

Bidding Documents, including Drawings, Project Manual, and Bid Forms, may be obtained at the office of Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc., 369 East Park Drive, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17111 starting October 7, 2009 at a nonrefundable cost of Fifty One Dollars and Fifty Cents plus 6% sales tax for a cost of Fifty Four Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents (\$54.59). Documents will be mailed first class at an additional cost of Five Dollars and Fifty Cents per set plus 6% sales tax for a cost of Five Dollars and Eight-Three Cents (\$5.83) made payable to Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc.

Bidding Documents may be examined at Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc., 369 East Park Drive, Harrisburg, PA 17111, weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m starting October 7, 2009.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid total.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or the award of a grant or grants, in which case the Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the actual date of the opening thereof in compliance with the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142).

Bidders must comply with all State anti-bid-rigging regulations pertaining to work associated with this project, and will be required to submit an executed non-collusion affidavit with the bid.

Bidders should refer to provisions of federal and state statutes, rules and regulations dealing with the prevention of environmental pollution and preservation of public natural resources that affect the project, said provisions being pursuant to Act No. 247 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved October 26, 1972.

The Harrisburg Authority reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority, and to reject any or all proposals.
